
## **International Holocaust Remembrance Day**



The Consulate General of Italy commemorates International Holocaust Remembrance Day, January 27th, by reading the names of Italian Jews who were deported from Italy on Monday 29th. In memory of the victims, the Consulate General of Italy, the Italian Cultural Institute, Centro Primo Levi, Casa Italiana Zerilli-Marimò at NYU, the Italian Academy at Columbia University, the Calandra Institute at CUNY, and La Scuola d'Italia Guglielmo Marconi will host multiple educational programs concerning the ideologies that lead to the Holocaust, such as antisemitism.

January 27, 2018 marks the 73nd anniversary of the <u>liberation of Auschwitz</u> [2] in 1945, and is memorialized as International Holocaust Remembrance Day. International Holocaust Remembrance Day commemorates the survivors and victims of the <u>Holocaust</u> [3], a mass genocide that took the lives of an estimated 6 million Jews, and millions of others during World War II.

On the 29th, the <u>Consulate General of Italy</u> [4] will pay homage to those who were affected by the Holocaust. There will be a reading of names of Italian Jews who were deported from Italy, and its territories. At this ceremony, the importance of New York City will also be recognized. It became a safehaven for Jews seeking refuge from their home countries. New York City gave them freedoms, and the opportunity to start a new life safe from the Nazi-Fascist persecution.

In addition, the Consulate General of Italy, the Italian Cultural Institute, Centro Primo Levi, Casa Italiana Zerilli-Marimò at NYU, the Italian Academy at Columbia University, the Calandra Institute at CUNY, and La Scuola d'Italia Guglielmo Marconi will host a series of educational programs to educate the youth about topics like totalitarianism, racism, and antisemitism, all ideologies that lead to the Holocaust. It is important to remember, and to learn from the hatred, racism, and discrimination of the past to ensure that history does not repeat itself.
